It is I myself! Touch me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have.' ⁴⁰ When he had said this, he showed them his hands and feet. ⁴¹ And while they still did not believe it because of joy and amazement, he asked them, 'Do you have anything here to eat?' ⁴² They gave him a piece of broiled fish, ⁴³ and he took it and ate it in their presence. ⁴⁴ He said to them, 'This is what I told you while I was still with you: everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms.' ⁴⁵ Then he opened their minds so they could understand the

DAILY DEVOTIONS, REFLECTIONS AND SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS WRITTEN BY REV KEDIBONE MNTAMBO

In today's gospel reading we hear another episode of the Risen Christ appearing to his disciples. Jesus appeared to them and said, "Peace be with you." They thought they were seeing a ghost and were scared half to death. But he reassured them, don't be upset, and don't let all these doubting questions take over. Look at my hands; look at my feet; it's really me. Touch me. Take my hand. Look me over from head to toe. A ghost doesn't have muscle and bone like this. Jesus was still Jesus they knew but they still couldn't believe what they were seeing. It was too much; it seemed too good to be true! We have this idea that the Resurrection of Jesus is somehow the end of the story. Maybe because it comes at the end of the gospels, but this is just the beginning. This is something new, which has reshaped our world forever, the entire creation... Enhanced... Renewed... Restored... Resurrected. It has already begun, here and now. In all the messiness of life, we can see glimpses of glory. In pain we can find hope. In desolation, we can find consolation because He is risen... despite the darkness and cruelty in today's life, the defense of the status quo and the poverty and pain around us.

The fact of the resurrection should radically reshape our hearts, minds, and worldview because the new creation is here, right under our noses. And we should begin to live in the light of that knowledge and hope. As a church, let's take Christ at his word. Put our hand into his, and fearlessly be the resurrection church in our community. A beacon of hope. A people whose song is "Christ is Risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!"



SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS:

1. How do we know that the disciples were worthy and honourable witnesses to Jesus' Resurrection?
2. Why is the Resurrection important? What does it mean to you personally?
3. How can you live out the hope of the Resurrection in your family, small group and community this next week?

Pray daily: Set up family time for prayer and devotions and stick to this arrangement. All devotions should always begin by with a prayer. Ask a family member to pray or one of the children.

Scripture Reading: Luke 24:36-48

Allow children/teens to read out loud for the family.

Activity/Family Moment:

This scripture talks a lot about doubts like last week. One way we can overcome our doubts is to remember the creeds. The word creed come from the Latin word Credos which means "I believe". The creeds are a summary of what we Christians believe. There are a few creeds. The one below is the Nicene Creed. Read it out as a family and talk about what your family thinks about it.

The Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, light from light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father; through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven, he became incarnate from the Virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father [and the Son], who with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets.

We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins.

We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.
